Feminist economy diagnosis a contradiction between sustainability of life and capital.

This contradiction is rising from the fact that: in capitalist economy growth is unlimited.

With the motivation of unlimited growth, the world is treated as a source to be limitlessly used and abused, which ends up to overexploitation of collective means of living with the finite conditions that sustains life.

The value and profit created in the capitalist system, remains at the hand of certain groups.

Housework being unpaid and invisible, it is excluded² from the economy. Yet, we know, invisible labor is the very thing which makes possible the reproduction of life.

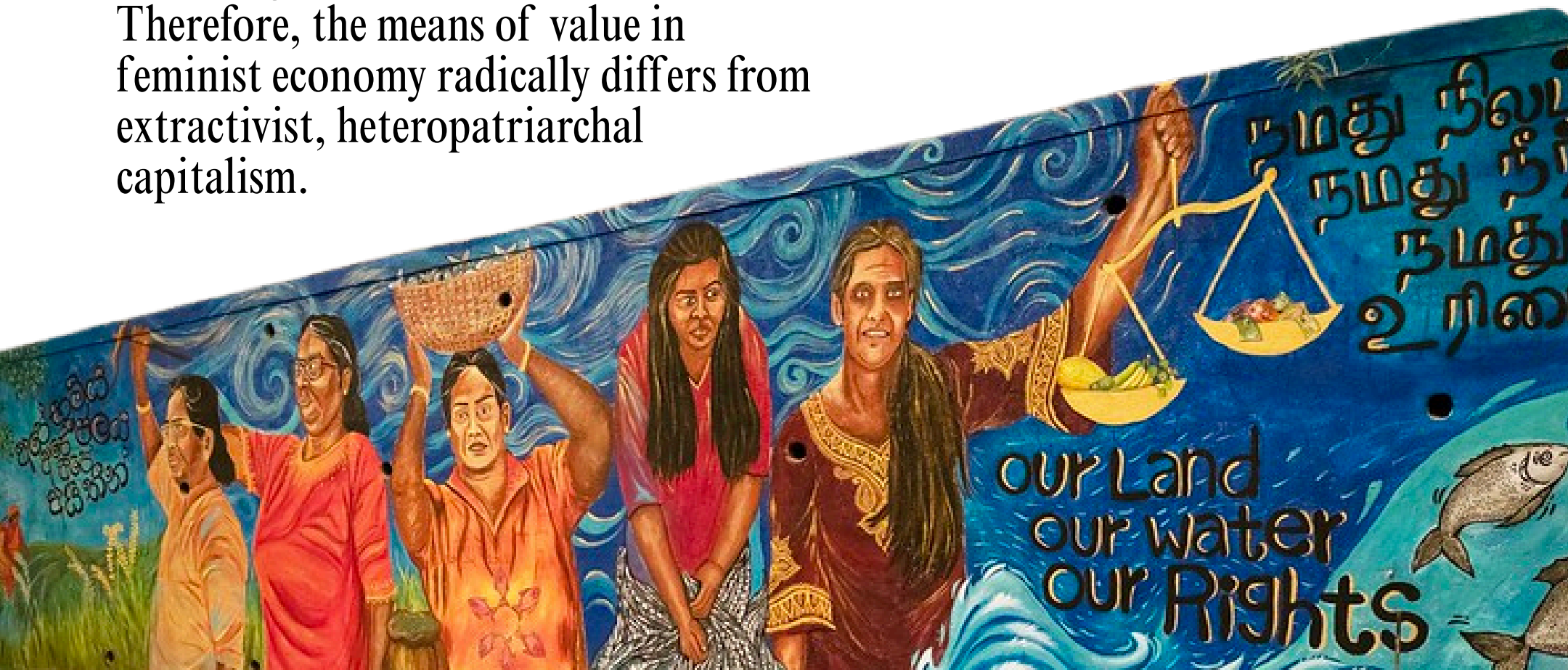


“To say that we want wages for housework is to expose the fact that housework is already money for capital.”

***Buen vivir** is to live in balance with the needs of other living beings and the planet; in societies where what is good for everyone is achieved without exclusion or oppression.*

***Food sovereignty** recognizes local communities as the principal actors in the fight against poverty and hunger. It demands autonomy, calls for agrarian reform and collective ownership of territories.*
